



HOPE FOR THE MIDDLE EAST

Thank you for praying, giving, signing the global One Million Voices of Hope petition, and asking others to sign too! Last year, supporters in the UK and Ireland raised an incredible £2.95 million to support our brothers and sisters in Syria and Iraq with vital aid and long-term projects. Nidal from Iraq received food aid when she was forced to flee her home to escape the self-proclaimed Islamic State. She says, "That kept us alive and hopeful and helped us hope for better times."

Your support also enables Open Doors to ensure the voices of persecuted Christians are heard by those in power. Tobias Ellwood, Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs, says, "Open Doors makes a major contribution to the Government's thinking to try to support Christians and other religious communities in the Middle East and North Africa."

Secret Children

Thanks to supporters who have committed to give and pray regularly for children, Open Doors continues to offer practical help and care to thousands of children who are bullied, displaced or even orphaned for being Christian. In Chhattisgarh, India, 15 children and their families were brutally beaten and chased out of their village because of their Christian faith. Two other siblings were at school when the attack happened. They came home to find their houses vandalised, their families gone, and only their elderly grandmother left behind. With help from Open Doors partners, the children were reunited with their parents and given food and clothing. The families all received medical aid and safe shelter until they could go home. Thank you for helping to assure these children and their families that they haven't been forgotten.
