Questions to ask at your local hustings

- 1. If you become an MP, how will you engage with issues of international freedom of religion or belief?
- 2. If your party forms the next government, in which ways will it stand up for freedom of religion or belief around the world?
- 3. The international right to freedom of religion or belief can contribute to countering extremism, encouraging economic development, and building resilience within communities. What are your party's plans for protecting the right to freedom of religion or belief in the government's foreign policy and aid strategy?
- 4. A number of potential post-Brexit trade partners feature on the Open Doors' *World Watch List*, an annual report assessing the 50 most dangerous countries in the world in which to be a Christian. How will your party ensure that each new international trade deal formulated once the UK has left the European Union will respect human rights, including the international right to freedom of religion or belief?
