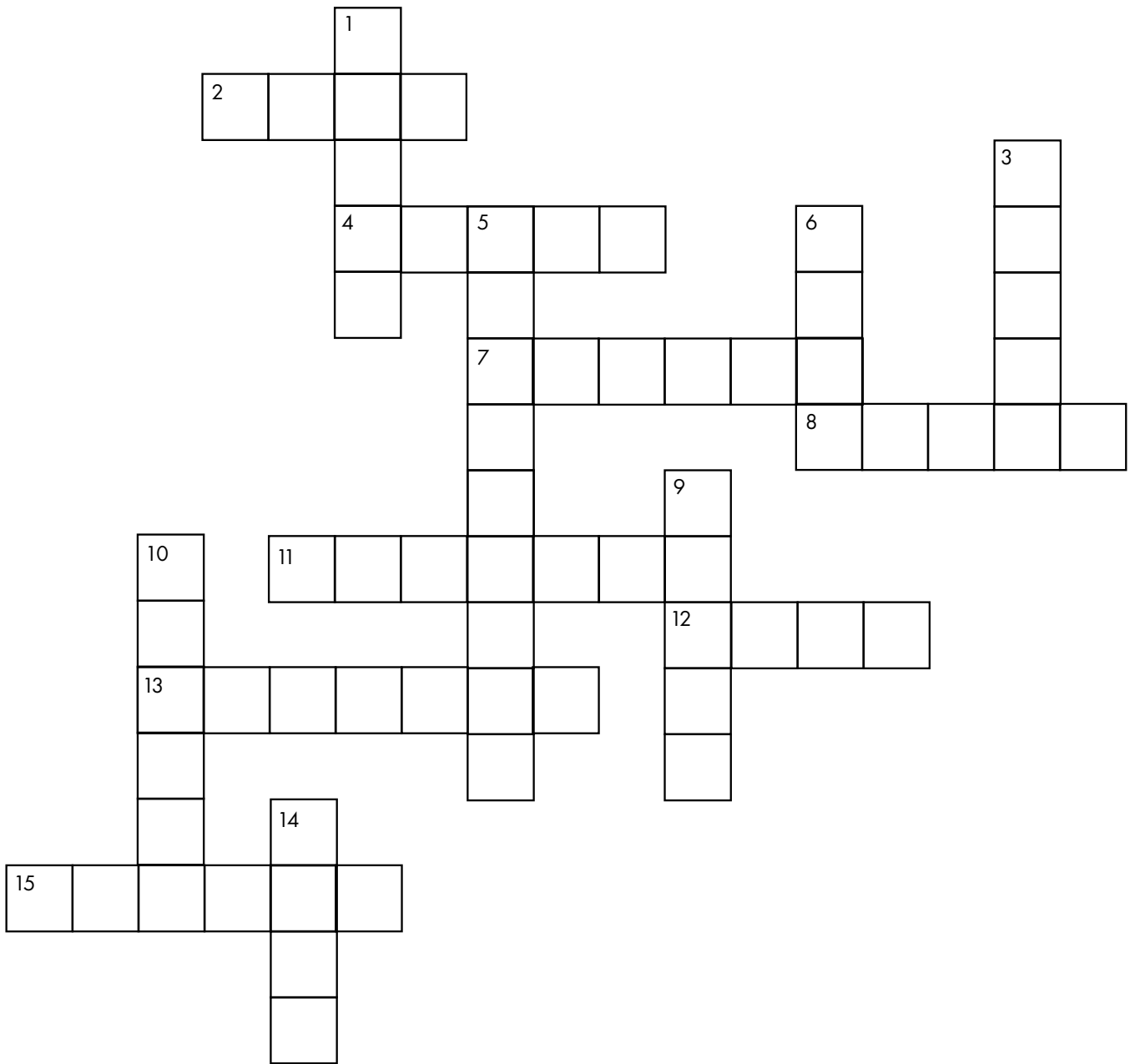

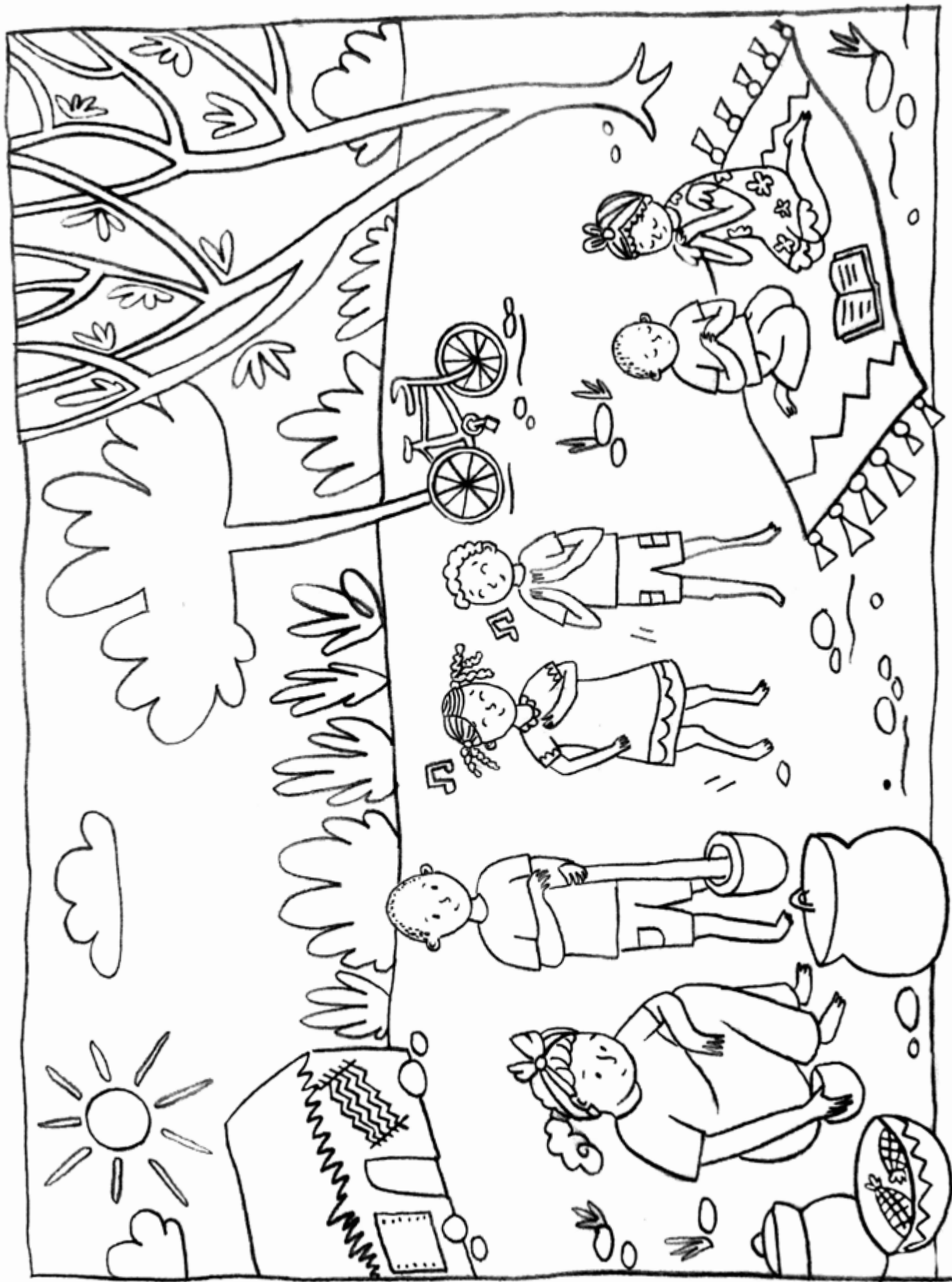
Can you find the answers? For some of the countries, you might need to look at a map of Africa.

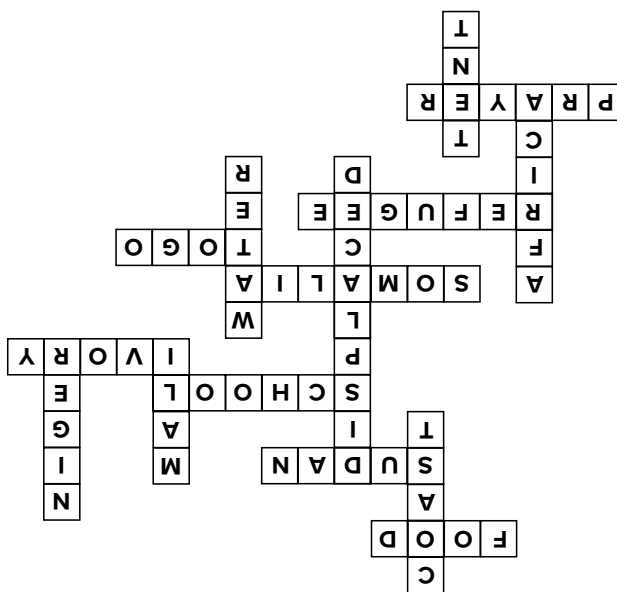
- 1** Together with 8 across, an African country where Christians are still experiencing persecution. Found between Ghana and Liberia.
